<p>Study programs for exchange students</p>	<p>Semester Study Program: Exchange students are allowed to register up to 22 credits per semester, and also can take any courses throughout the colleges (except some experiment or practical training classes). <p>Tuition fee</p>	<p>Tuition fee is waived. The students, enrolled at the program, may apply for scholarship after arrival at KGU.</p>

<p>Accommodation facilities</p>	<p>Dormitory: Each room is fully equipped with basic facilities such as bed, desk & chair, bookshelf, closet, air conditioner, TV, and refrigerator. Bed linens are also prepared. You can access the Internet (Wi-Fi) from your room. A small kitchen, toilet, public bath, shower rooms and washing machines are located in the common space. Breakfast and dinner is provided at the dining room from Monday to Saturday.</p> <p>Accommodation fee: from JPY 211,500 to JPY 282,000 (depending on the chosen options; subject to be changed).</p>
<p>Health insurance</p>	<p>Private health insurance must be valid throughout your study program period.</p> <p>National Health Insurance is required for foreigners who stay more than 3 months in Japan.</p> <p>KGU Insurance for Students is including to the above Program Fees.</p> <p>All exchange students are required to sign up National Health Insurance (12,000 yen) and KGU Insurance (7,000 yen).</p>
<p>Arrival airport/railway station</p>	<p>Narita Airport or Haneda Airport in Tokyo</p>
<p>Pick up service</p>	<p>Host university will arrange the pick up service (the students have to prepare their arrival information and inform PNU coordinator at least 3 working days before the date of their flight). In order for the KGU staff to meet students upon their arrival, it is requested that students arrive at the Airport (Narita or Haneda) by 3 pm on the in-coming day.</p>
